Instructions

- 1. Score lightly along dotted lines.
- 2. Cut out along solid lines.
- 3. Fold along scored lines.
- 4. Place a line of glue where indicated and seal.

MIXED COLOURS

Papaver orientale

Flowers spring to early summer. Perennial

WHERE AND WHEN? Sow seeds directly to soil in area of full sun.

PLANT DETAILS: Flowers and spreads abundantly. Will self sow. Flowers the second year. Drought resistant but likes evenly moist soil.

MAINTENANCE: Will go dormant in mid summer. Cut off yellow or dead leaves. Transplant in spring or fall.

Aquilegia

Late spring flowering. Short-lived Perennial

WHERE AND WHEN? Direct sow in early spring, mid summer, or fall. Plant in full sun or partial shade.

PLANT DETAILS: Thrives in mild climates. In hot climates grow in partial shade. Will self sow profusely.

MAINTENANCE: Deadhead (cut off dead flowers) regularly to encourage continuous blooms and to avoid self seedisng.
